SAY NO TO MORE WIND TURBINES

The Community survey we conducted in 2012 demonstrated that the vast majority of Newbald residents do not wish to see any more wind turbines in the area.

When the planning application to extend the wind farm at Sancton by up to **11 turbines** is submitted, as it invariably will be soon, **we will need your help if we are going to successfully campaign against it.**

There are two ways in which you can help. **Firstly** please take 2 minutes to visit our website www.newbald.com now and complete the very short survey to show your opposition to the scheme. (Of course, if you are in favour, you can indicate that too).

Secondly, when the application does come in, please be ready to write a personal letter of objection to the planning department at East Riding of Yorkshire Council. We will inform you when this happens and issue templates and advice so you can do this quickly and effectively. See www.newbald.com for more information.
