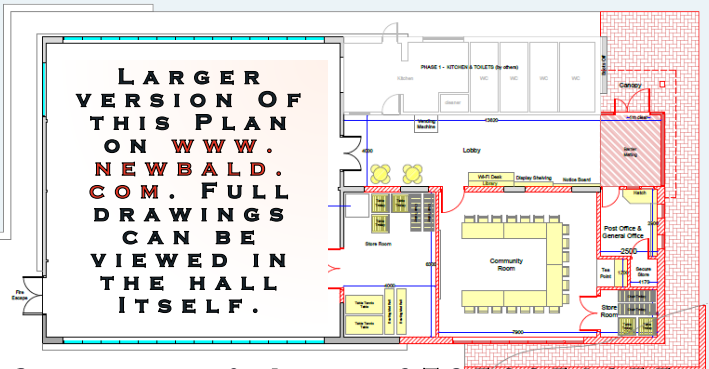

Two and half years ago yellow lines were drawn on the ground as to where we could put a meeting room to meet the needs expressed by Newbald residents – and this month will see the start of the construction of Phase 2 – a storage area, a carpeted community room for 40+, an office and new entrance. All this has meant £130,780 had to be found to fund the project, and thanks to the R B Massey Memorial Fund, the Newbald Parish Council, Newbald Village Hall Committee and LEADER (Liaison Entre Actions de Développement de l'Economie Rurale) we achieved the build costs. This facility will provide an
