## COUNCILLOR CHANGES

Following the recent election and resignations, Members are sad to say goodbye to Councillors Elsie Huntington, Ed Openshaw and Terry Bowater. We would like to thank each of them for their commitment, service and valuable contribution. Elsie has been on the Council for many years and more recently served as Parish Transport Champion. For 4 years, Ed. Openshaw was the linchpin between the Village Hall and NPC and was a key player in securing all the positive changes at the Hall. He also did all our health & safety inspections and was our chief photographer. Terry Bowater was instrumental in improving the Christmas Tree lights on The Green, setting up a temporary stay, having sold in Tickton and not knowing where we wanted to live. After 6 months we had fallen in love with the village. We secured a property here, renovated it significantly and moved in. Having always paid attention to what happens in the village, I thought it was time to get involved."

## USE OR LOSE THE NEW POCKLINGTON BUS SERVICE

Subsidised by a Sober Hill Wind Farm grant, the new fortnightly community bus service is designed to help disabled, elderly and rurally isolated people get out and about. So far, the uptake has been poor. The meeting room, storage, office and new entrance are well on target thanks to the builders' hard work and the brilliant weather, and we should be finished by the end of July. The initial funding from R B Massey Memorial Trust, Newbald Parish Council, and LEADER has enabled us to construct the new extensions, but this funding did not cover the finishing off costs. In March we heard from the Bernard Sunley Foundation that we have been awarded £10000! This means the painting can be done, automatic disabled doors installed both at the entrance and inside, and electric blinds to the



elevated meeting room windows. This generous support will be the icing on the cake!

This meeting room is already attracting much interest from potential users – so if you are interested in setting up a new club, or are looking for a venue to hold a small event or meeting, the meeting room is ideal.

These changes can only provide brilliant facilities for our village and support the community.
